Thank you for registering for the Spring Splash Paddle on the Odessa Water Trail. This guided kayak and canoe trip will be an adventurous paddle winding through the panoramic wildlife area. Paddlers can expect to see herons, wood ducks, other waterfowl and more!

INCLUDED IN THIS PACKET: this info sheet, map/directions, canoe waiver form

WHAT TO WEAR / BRING:

- Appropriate clothing for the weather. It is important to dress in layers, so you can add or remove articles as needed.
- Comfortable footwear that can get wet.
- Lunch and snacks in a small cooler or waterproof bag.
- Plenty of water to drink - at least 2 bottles & have a way to tie them into your boat.
- Change of clothing and towel to be kept in your vehicle just in case.

Please remember that everything you bring in your boat could get wet (or fall out of your boat). Put anything you don't want wet into freezer zip-lock bags (great for cameras or binoculars) or another water proof container.

WE PROVIDE:

- The canoe or kayak you've reserved including paddles and lifejackets.

THINGS TO KNOW:

- Kids 16 & under must be accompanied by an adult.
- Must sign a canoe liability waiver (included in this document—fill it out and bring it along)
- Everyone will be required to wear a life jacket.
- Paddle starts at 9:00 am at Snively Campground - you should arrive around 8:30 to get your personal boat unloaded & ready to go.
- Parking will be at north end of the campground. Signs will be posted.

IN CASE OF BAD WEATHER:

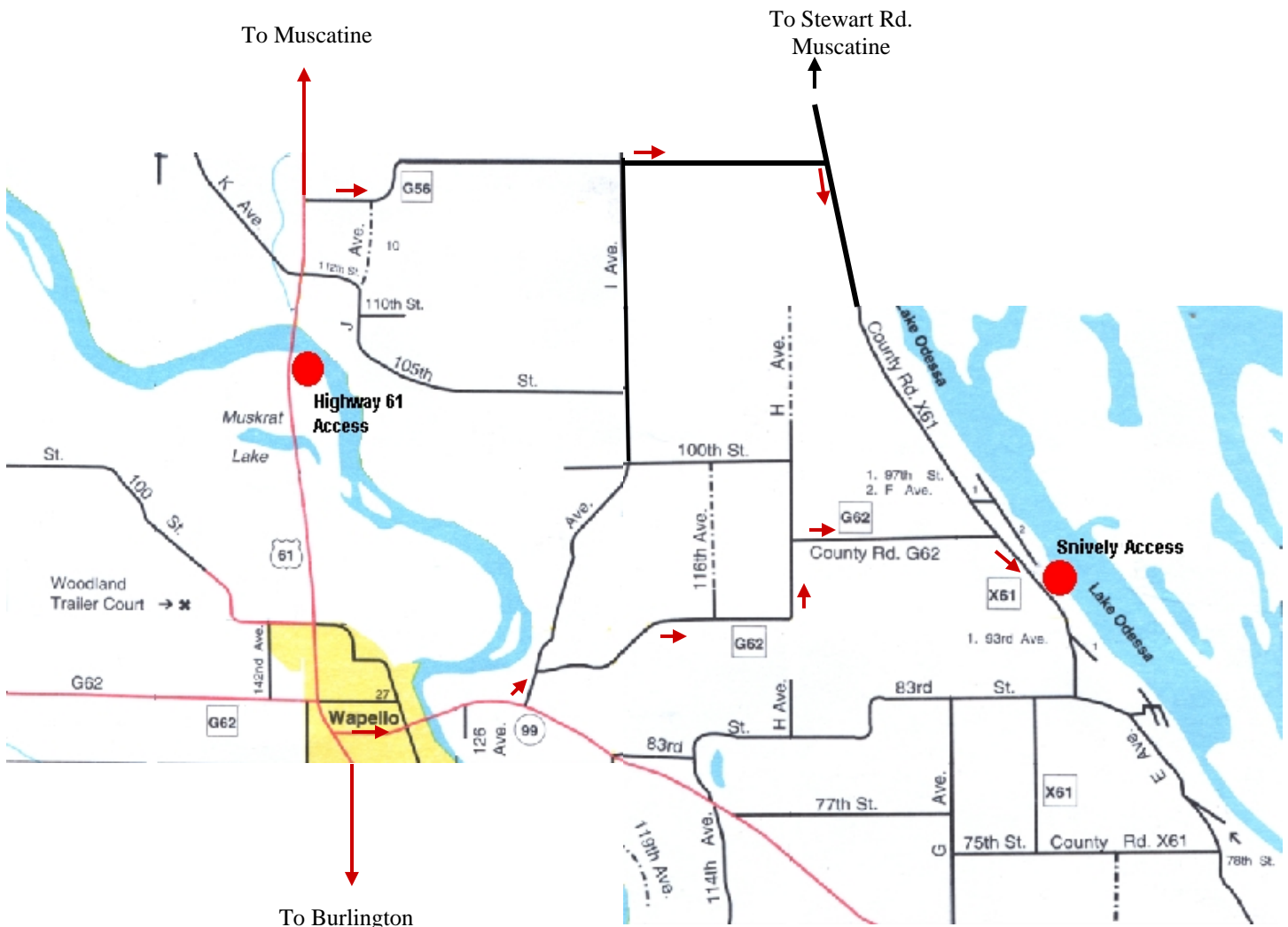
- If canceled you will be contacted by email and/or phone. There will also be a message on our office answering machine. Call (319) 523-8381 if you are unsure.
- If there is a cancellation due to weather this event will not be rescheduled.

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Directions to Snively Access

From North of Wapello: Turn left (east) off Hwy 61 onto G-56 (Highway sign says to Port Louisa National Wildlife Refuge and Odessa Wildlife Management Area). At the “T” intersection turn right onto X-61. Snively Access will be on the left in about three miles.

From South of Wapello: In Wapello, turn off Hwy 61 (east) onto Co. Rd 99. After you cross the Iowa River Bridge take the first left onto G-62. Follow G-62 until you reach the “T” intersection and turn right. Watch for a left turn to Snively Access

Contract Conditions

I, the undersigned, being 18 years of age or older, hereby realize boating is a water sport which involves risk and danger and agree to abide by all the state laws and regulations governing the use of this boat. I assume all responsibility, not only for myself, but for the safety of all passengers with me. I take full responsibility for loss or damage to any equipment and will replace it at retail value.

I further agree specifically to:

- __1. Not allow more than three (3) persons in this boat (a child of any age is a person).
- __2. **Not allow persons to operate or ride in this boat without wearing a properly fitting lifejacket.**
- __3. Not dive from this boat.
- __4. Not allow anyone to operate this boat in a reckless manner.
- __5. Assume responsibility for this canoe and equipment until turned over to the Louisiana County Conservation Board staff.
- __6. Indemnify, save and hold harmless Louisiana County, its Directors, officers and employees, from and against any and all claims and demands for, or in connection with, any accident, injury, death, or damage whatsoever caused to any person or property arising, directly or indirectly, out of the rental or use of personal property pursuant to the Canoe Waiver and from and against any and all costs, expenses, and liabilities incurred in connection with any such claim or proceeding brought thereon.
